Across a network of agencies, programs and services, we're offering free tax preparation services for workers and taxpayers. We're initiating programs that offer training and education to youths and adults that helps prepare them for a better future.

We are more than the fundraisers. We are the problem solvers, the hand raisers, the Difference Makers. We surround a community's most critical problems — and we stand UNITED.

Alongside our partner agencies we're offering hope and help where it's needed the most. In the last year alone, United Way of Hancock County impacted thousands of people, providing:

- 242 households were assisted in transitioning from homelessness to permanent housing
- Over 37,000 low-cost rides for individuals needing transportation to medical visits, work, and other necessities
- 3,554 nights of service were given to women and children in need of safe, reliable housing

We are strengthening our community from the inside out, but there's still so much more to do. We're standing UNITED and moving forward to build a better tomorrow today.
